



VBC SUMMER BASEBALL CAMP COUNSELOR POSITIONS and LEADERSHIP TRAINING – You must reply by apply by April 15,

The Virginia Baseball Club (VBC) is looking for **reliable, mature and responsible** baseball players to work at the VBC Summer Baseball Camps. This work offers flexible hours and good pay. VBC counselors receive valuable leadership training and the opportunity to learn and apply leadership skills.

The VBC offers weekly summer baseball camps throughout Northern Virginia for players ages 5 through 15. Weekly camp hours are 9am-12pm, 9am-2pm, and 2pm-6pm (PM Extended hours at some locations). Our goals are to provide an enjoyable and valuable baseball experience to all participants.

All applicants must:

- Have good grades, good attendance and be very reliable and responsible.
- Must be at least 14 years old:
 1. Current (spring 2017) eighth and ninth graders volunteer in the “VBC leaders in training” program. Counselors who successfully participate in this program have priority consideration for future paid positions with VBC.
 2. Current (spring 2017) tenth graders and older may apply for paid positions
- Enjoy working with youth players.
- Have good leadership and communication skills.

Counselors may apply to work one week or several weeks during the summer. The pay scale ranges from \$6.55 to \$9.50 per hour.

Counselor positions will be assigned based on the following criteria:

- 1) Successful completion of the application and forms and attendance to VBC leadership training workshop in early June.
- 2) A positive recommendations from former employer(s) or HS coach,
- 3) VBC needs for counselors at certain camp sites. Work assignments are based on enrollment numbers from previous year’s VBC camps. Positions may increase or decrease based on current enrollment numbers.

To apply for VBC counselor positions follow these steps:

- 1) Fill out the online applicant information at (link) by **April 15. This is a secure site.**
- 2) You must upload a **recommendation letter from your coach** and a **copy of your current year first semester report card.**
- 3) Applicants who will be 18 years old or older must print the CPS form, have it notarized, and mail to VBC by May 1st.
- 4) All counselors (including past VBC summer counselors) are **required** to attend a 4-hour training session held in early June AND complete an online leadership certification test.

If we accept your fully completed application, VBC will email the first draft of summer camp counselor assignments by May 15, Specific information regarding the staff training meeting and the online certification test will follow.
